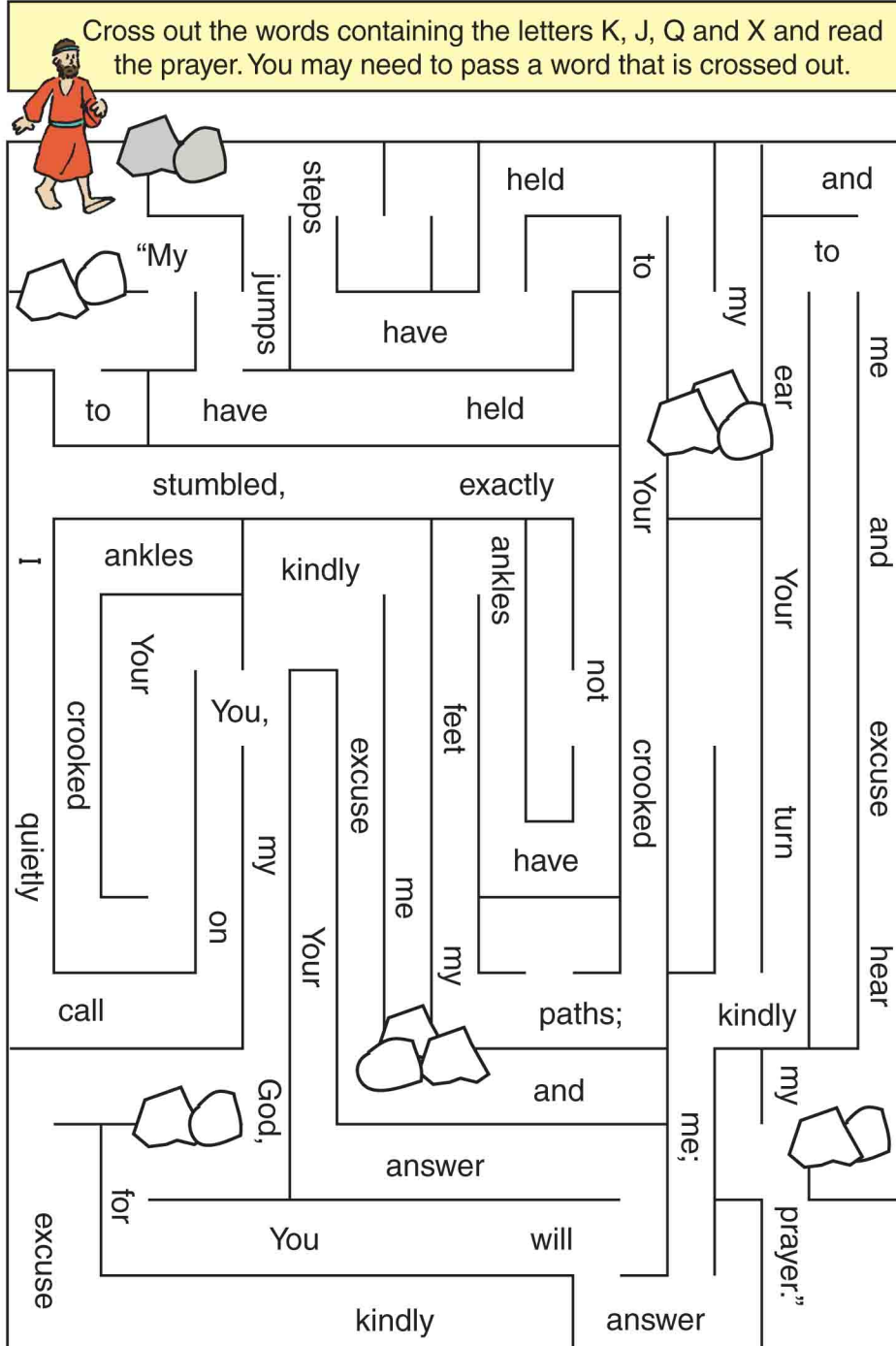


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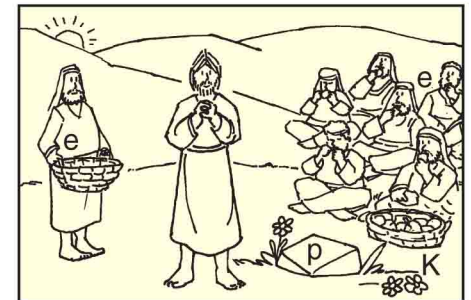
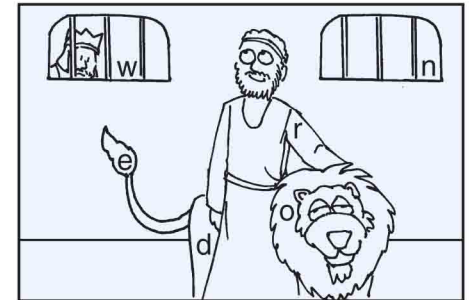
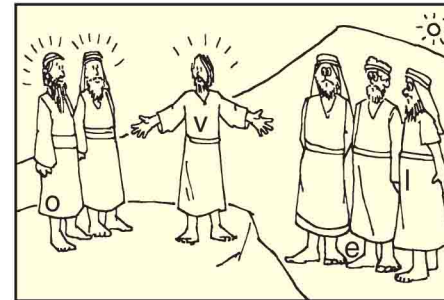
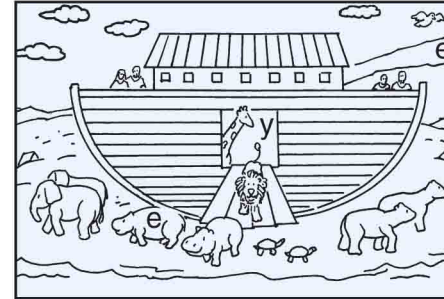
The psalmist said he had been faithful to God.
