Administered by the General Board of Church and Society, Peace with Justice contributions support programs that witness to God's demands for a faithful, just, disarmed, and secure world.

- **Fifty percent of the funds raised on Peace with Justice Sunday stay within the United Methodist Annual Conference** to enhance and support local social justice ministries. To sustain and build these efforts, the Book of Discipline calls upon each Annual Conference to have a Peace With Justice Coordinator. The Conference Coordinator focuses on providing educational resources, fostering relationships, and mobilizing networks for social advocacy and action.
- **Fifty percent of the donations collected support national and international peacemaking ministries and grants.** Our mission is to promote shalom for all of God's people. Two distinct grants are offered to United Methodist congregations and organizations that focus on Ethnic/Minority Local Church ministries and programs related to Peace with Justice ministries.

One of the denomination's six special offerings, Peace with Justice Sunday encourages United Methodists to participate in transforming the world and challenging injustice by calling on our leaders and elected officials to prioritize policies that support communities and reflect God's economy of abundance and grace.
